

Research Fellowship

Egg Nutrition Center - 2012

The Egg Nutrition Center and American Egg Board (ENC-AEB) fund a dissertation fellowship program to support students pursuing a doctoral degree in nutrition with emphasis on understanding the nutritional value of eggs in a healthy diet. Eligibility:

Applicants should be Ph.D. degree candidates studying nutrition or nutrition-related fields at an accredited U.S. university. Students must be U.S. citizens with the desire for a career in teaching and research in nutrition.

Application:

Deadline: Friday, March 16, 2012

A Letter of Intent (LOI) will be used for initial screening. Only selected proposals will be invited to submit a complete proposal. The LOI is limited to 2 pages, single spaced, 12-point font. The 2-page LOI should contain: Title, student name, advisor name, Department, and institution, a statement of purpose or hypothesis, specific aims, summary of approach or experimental design, importance of project to understanding nutritional value of eggs, and current stage of degree program. Full applications (by invitation) will be due May 15, 2012

Funding:

Total fellowship support provides up to \$38,000 per year with maximum length of three years based on satisfactory progress and continuous enrollment. Funds may be used with up to \$28,000 per year for Stipend support (depending upon institution's stipend rate) with the remaining funds applied to tuition, conference travel, laboratory supplies, and publications. Students are expected to use funds to attend a nutrition conference each year.
